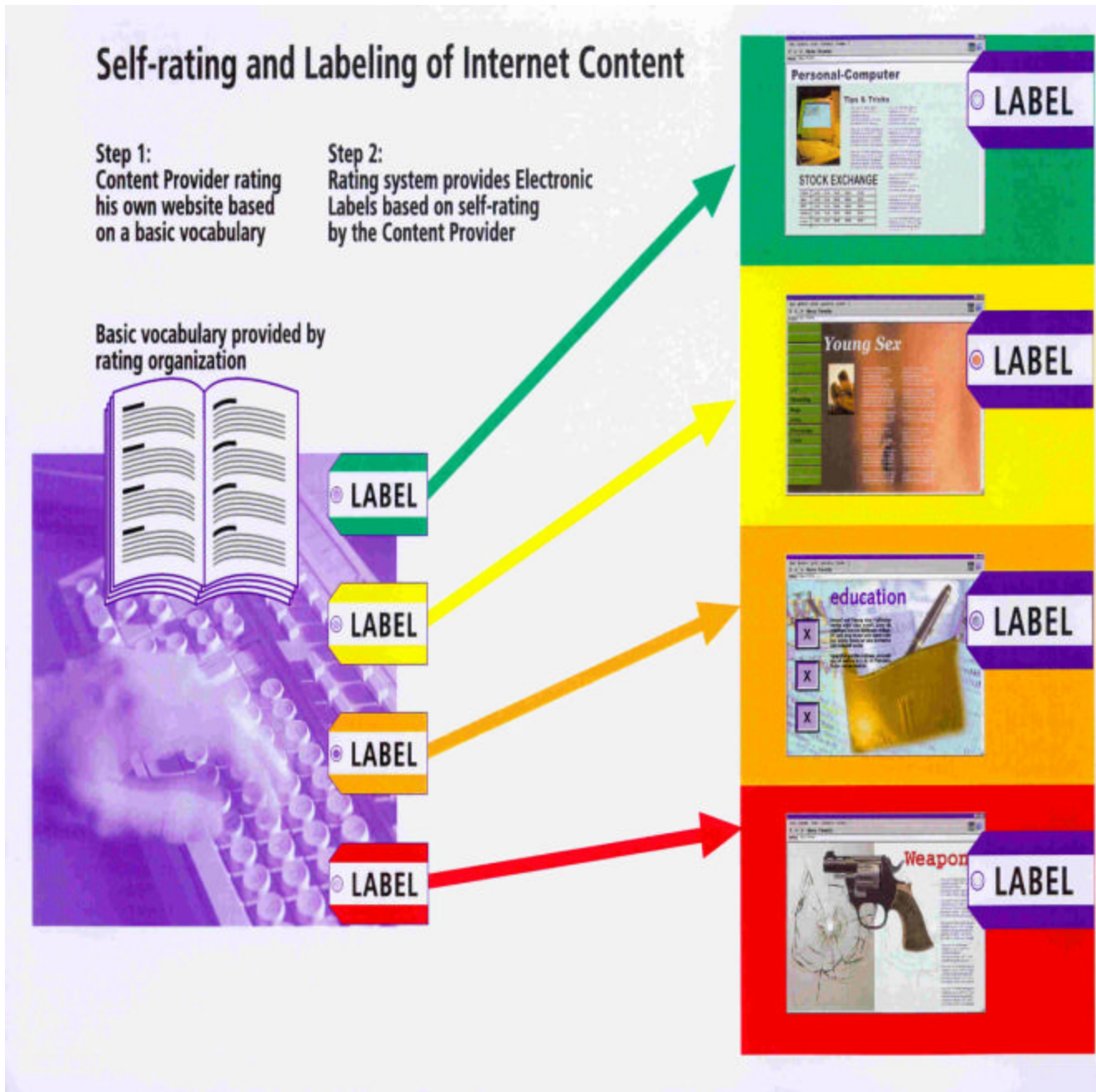


How to Label with ICRA

The ICRA labeling system is an open, objective, content-based rating system designed to provide filtering capability through the Web browser. The ICRA rating categories are based upon specific definitions that guide the Web author through a checklist of possible content. Our goal is to develop, monitor and continue to make improvements to ICRA to provide the most objective system possible to meet the needs of the public. The rating process is intended for **Web authors**. There is Help one click away at every step of the labeling process.
